Call for international experts of all disciplines for participation in External Evaluation and Accreditation Panels

The Hellenic Authority for Higher Education (HAHE) invites international experts of all disciplines, who are interested to participate in External Evaluation and Accreditation Panels for the accreditation review of undergraduate and postgraduate study programmes of Greek Higher Education Institutions.

The HAHE maintains a Register of experts including Greek and foreign scientists with an established reputation, professors teaching in non-Greek HEIs, and distinguished researchers from international Research Centers and Institutes. The Register also includes stakeholders with hands-on experience, executives with competency, and members of scientific associations, who can objectively assess the contribution of studies to professional practice.

A. Eligibility

i. For academic staff

- Ph.D degree
- Rank of an Associate/Full Professor
- Experience in HEI administration
- Experience in quality assurance activities (e.g. internal quality assurance system and/or study programme evaluation/accreditation) in Higher Education

Optional:

- Teaching and/or research in Total Quality Management
- Ability to read and understand working documents in Greek

ii. For members of research/professional bodies

- Membership in recognised research institutions/professional bodies
- Experience in quality assurance activities

Optional:

Ability to read and understand working documents in Greek

B. Requirements

All the experts are expected to:

- be fully proficient in the English language
- have an in-depth knowledge of the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education (ESG), and to be familiar with the relevant processes in the European Higher Education Area
- possess analytical, digital and social skills











- comply with the HAHE Code of Conduct
- abide by the Panel work schedule and the agreed task assignment

C. Selection

The HAHE examines all applications and informs the candidates on the outcome.

Please bear in mind that application in the HAHE Register of Experts does not automatically mean selection, participation and task assignment.

D. Accreditation Review Procedure

The Panel of external reviewers is composed of five members, of which one is a student. The members of the Panel who will be tasked with the accreditation review of a Higher Education study programme, will have to attend a short-term training. Attendance of this training is mandatory, and absence will be a reason of exclusion from the Panel. During the short-term training, the experts be provided with the necessary information and guidance on the review procedure. The review includes a site visit, either on-site or on-line, depending on the programme under review. After the site visit, the members of the Panel proceed with the drafting of the Accreditation Report and with its submission to the HAHE.

E. Financial compensation

Each Panel member will receive a daily allowance (per diem) of 100 euros for a maximum of six days. In addition, travelling and accommodation expenses (if applicable) will be covered by the HAHE.

F. Application

Perspective experts who fulfil the selection criteria described in section A, may apply and submit their CV in the HAHE Register of Experts at http://experts.ethaae.gr

The current call is permanently open, in order to enrich the HAHE database of international experts in various disciplines.
